### **Prof. Mark Mason**

Mark Mason is Professor and Head of the Department of International Education and Lifelong Learning at The Hong Kong Institute of Education, working in the field of comparative and international education and development, from a disciplinary background in philosophy, social theory and education studies.

He is Regional Editor (Asia & the Pacific) of the *International Journal of Educational Development* (Elsevier), Editor of the *CERC Studies in Comparative Education Series* (Springer), Editor of the *Comparative Education Bulletin*, Editor of the *CERC Monograph Series in Comparative and International Education and Development*, and Associate Editor of the *Southern African Review of Education*. He serves on the Editorial Boards of *Educational Philosophy and Theory* (Blackwell), *Ethics and Education* (Routledge), *Bristol Papers in Education: Comparative and International Studies* (Symposium Books), and the *Spanish Journal of Comparative Education*.

He is Past President of the Comparative Education Society of Hong Kong and the former Director of the Comparative Education Research Centre at The University of Hong Kong. He has presented keynote and plenary addresses on invitation from UNESCO, government and other development agencies, from the International Baccalaureate Organization, and from professional societies in philosophy of education, in educational development, in sociology, and in comparative and international education. He has provided consultancy services in educational development in South-East Asia, Southern Africa and more widely, for government, non-government, UNESCO and other development agencies. He has published more than 100 articles, chapters, books and journal special issues in these research areas, and his work has been translated and published in French, Spanish, Italian, Chinese and Japanese.

As a former Fulbright Scholar, he holds a doctorate from Columbia University.
